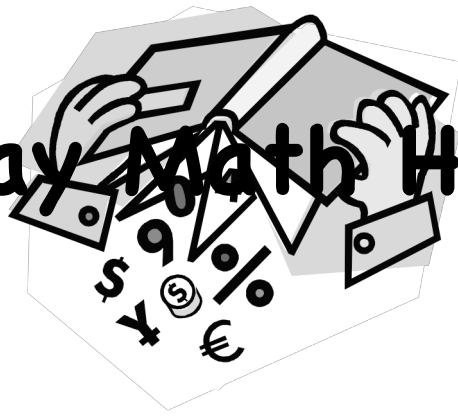


Everyday Math Homelinks
